A VERY WARM WELCOME to our new pastor, Fr. Fred Wendel. There will be a **reception** to welcome Fr. Fred in the Fellowship Hall after the Masses on 12-13 July. 13 July is Name Tag Sunday.

OUR NEW PASTOR, Fr. Fred, was born in Seattle, WA and adopted by his parents, Vera and Al Wendel, when his father was stationed at Fort Lewis, WA. He is the son of a career Army officer who retired at Fort McPherson, GA. His parents are both deceased and he is an only child. Fr. Fred grew up in Atlanta, attending both secondary school and college in the state of Georgia. He served in the Army beginning 23 July 1970, for several years. Following his service he returned to Atlanta, completed college and then went on to the seminary. He was accepted by the Diocese of Cheyenne, Wyoming and attended seminary at St. Thomas in Denver, Colorado. He was ordained a priest on 9 June 1978. While serving in Wyoming, he was an Army National Guard Chaplain for 8 years. In 1997 he returned to Atlanta and the Archdiocese of Atlanta where he continued in the Chaplaincy until 1999, when he resigned his commission and received a second Honorable Discharge. He was also the pastor of 2 parishes while in Atlanta. On 1 July 2008, Fr. Wendel came on Active Duty as a Regular Army Chaplain. He has served at Fort Belvoir, Fort McPherson, the Chaplain Career Course at Fort Jackson, SC and Warner Barracks in Bamberg, Germany. His interests include: working out, traveling, long distance bicycling, movies, cars and reading. His picture is on our website.
