Reflection on our Scripture

Wisdom 12:13, 16-19 – The book of Wisdom 2 was written about 50 years before Christ.

In one lengthy section of this book, the author looks back to the wonderful things God did for the Jewish people during the exodus. In today's passage from that section, the author speaks directly to God with words of praise.
