Dear Catholic Community at Joint Base Myer-Henderson Hall:

I really like the First Reading from the First Book of Kings. It's a reminder to us that God is a "God of surprise." We often have our expectations of God. We, too, often seek to make God into our image and likeness. We need to be reminded of the opposite. We are made in His image. God is all-powerful and yet, as in the first reading, God doesn't only come in fire and power. God comes in the tiniest whisper - the softest breeze.
