**Dear Catholic Community at Joint Base Myer-Henderson Hall:**

**CATHOLIC RELIGIOUS EDUCATION: JBM-HH CRE begins 21 SEPTEMBER after the 0900 Mass. Classes meet Sundays from 1030 to 1130 at the JBM-HH Education Center next to Summerall Field on Sheridan Avenue. Classes do not meet on weekends with a federal holiday and the schedule includes Christmas and Easter breaks. CRE classes include Kindergarten through Eighth Grades, as well as a class for high school students. IF you have children who are ready to prepare for First Holy Communion or Confirmation, a parent must be active duty military OR a letter must be obtained from your local civilian pastor giving permission to receive sacraments at JBM-HH Catholic Community. Registration for CRE begins the end of August and runs through the first weeks of September.
