First Reading: Deuteronomy 4:32-34, 39-40

Second Reading: Romans 8:14-17

The book of Deuteronomy contains a lengthy speech that Moses addressed to the people as they prepared to enter the Promised Land. This was a place where the people worshipped many gods and goddesses. Moses reminds them that there is only one God – the One who brought them out of Egypt.

Paul's letter to the Romans is his most detailed and important theological work. In this portion of the letter, Paul stresses the importance of the Holy Spirit in the lives of Christians. Through the Spirit's presence within us, we enjoy not only new life but also a new relationship with God, whom we can call by a new name.
