Introduction to Today's Readings

First Reading: Genesis 2:18-24
Second Reading: Hebrews 2: 9-11
The first 11 chapters of Genesis have very little historical foundation but they teach religious truths in parable form. In Chapter One and Chapter Two, there are two quite different accounts of creation. Today we hear a part of the second account.
Today and for the next six Sundays, our second reading will come from the Letter to the Hebrews. The section from which today's passage is taken is perhaps the New Testament's most profound commentary on the implication of Jesus becoming a human being.
