**INTRODUCTION TO THIS WEEKEND'S READINGS**

**First Reading** **Malachi 1:14-2:2,8-10**

The book of Malachi was written after the Jews returned from exile in Babylon. The prophet expresses God's displeasure because, once the people returned to their homeland and enjoyed better times, they grew lax in their religious practices. Today's passage is directed to the Jewish priests in the temple, scolding them for their carelessness and indifference.

**Second Reading** **1 Thessalonians 2:7-9, 13**

Thessalonica was a city in northeastern Greece, where Christians were being persecuted. So, Paul wrote them a friendly and encouraging letter. In today's passage we will hear him use a touching image to describe his relationship with these people whom he loves.
