SOLEMNITY OF THE NATIVITY OF ST JOHN THE BAPTIST

SATURDAY VIGIL MASS

First Reading: Jeremiah 1:4–10

"Before I formed you in the womb I knew you."

Second Reading: 1 Peter 1:8–12

"The prophets who prophesied about the grace that was to be yours searched and investigated it."

SUNDAY MASS DURING THE DAY

First Reading: Isaiah 49:1 – 6

"I will make you a light to the nations."

Second Reading: Acts 13:22–26

"John heralded his coming by proclaiming a baptism of repentance."

While still in the womb, John the Baptist was called to prepare the people for the coming of the Lord. We hear today from Jeremiah or Isaiah, two prophets also called by the LORD before they were born. We ourselves were not called by God in such a dramatic way. Yet by virtue of baptism, each of us also shares in Christ's prophetic and salvific mission.
