

Pastoral Advisory Council Elections

Fellow Community Members:

Within your Joint Base Myer Henderson Hall (JBMHH) Catholic Community, change is in the air. With that change comes the responsibility for each of us to do our part to ensure the wonderful community we have all worked so hard to build, remains vibrant and continues to thrive for years to come.

Recently, your community leaders developed new Pastoral Advisory Council (PAC) bylaws (attached) designed to successfully guide the community in fulfilling its mission and objectives. One of the first actions required by the new bylaws is for the community, its standing committees and their respective ministries to identify, nominate and/or elect the representatives and officers that will serve on and lead the newly reconstituted PAC these bylaws establish.

Our community's four standing committees and their respective ministries each will soon individually select a voting representative to serve and represent their interests on the new PAC. If you have interest in serving as a representative of one of the four standing committees that your ministry is associated with please let your respective committee or ministry leader know of your interest immediately.

Simultaneously, the current PAC's nominating committee will be identifying six additional candidates to serve on the reconstituted PAC. This slate of candidates will consist of three officers (president, vice president and secretary) and three at-large representatives of the Saturday and Sunday service attendees and active duty, retired and civilian community members.

The nominating committee will compile a slate of candidates for these six positions from among community members expressing interest in serving and will present the slate to the current PAC for its consideration and approval. This newly elected slate of PAC members, along with the four put forth by the standing committees will be announced to the Community at the June 24 & 25 masses and their term of office will begin on July 1.
